# Step-by-Step Guide to Filling Out an AwardSpring Scholarship Application

### 1. Access AwardSpring:

 Visit the AwardSpring website and log in with your credentials. If you don't have an account, you'll need to register first.

### 2. Dashboard Overview:

Once logged in, you'll see your dashboard. This will show your progress and 0 any sections that need to be completed.

# 3. Start the Application:

o Click on the "Start Application" button to begin. If you've already started, this button may say "Complete Application."

# 4. Complete the Base Application:

- The base application consists of several sections:
  - General Information: Fill in your personal details.
  - Academic Information: Provide your academic history and current status.
  - Financial Information: Enter details about your financial situation.
  - Qualification Questions: Answer questions to determine your eligibility for specific scholarships.
  - Essay Responses: Write and upload any required essays.
  - Letters of Recommendation: While not always required, submitting • letters can strengthen your application. Only scholarships that require this will have this field appear.

# Additional Information about certain fields

- General Information: What best describes your Indigenous Ancestry?
  - This field is used as a qualifier for some scholarships. Either our donors earmark their donation for Indigenous students, which could include all 3 Indigenous groups of Canada, First Nations, Metis, and Inuit. In other cases, the scholarship is very specific and states the recipient must have Treaty Status and some even target specific First Nations. Please answer as completely and correctly as possible.
- Academic Information: Number of Credits currently enrolled:
  - This information is available on your UR Self-Service and/or your Academic Advisor can help you.
- Academic Information: Completed Credit Hours.
  - This information is available on your transcript from last term, if this is your first semester enter 0.
- Academic Information: UGPA
  - Available on your transcript
- Academic Information: PGPA
  - Available on Degree Audit on UR Self-service
- Financial Information: Sponsorship ٠
  - Your First Nations Post Secondary Department (ie. Lac La Ronge Indian Band) Post Sec)
  - GDI Metis Nation University Sponsorship Program
  - o Future Generations Fund (FGF formerly known as National Indian Brotherhood Trust Fund)
  - o If your sponsor pays for tuition, enter zero in that field, if they pay a portion then subtract that from the tuition amount and divide remainder by 4 (4 months per semester). This info will be verified with our finance department.
